



The Independent Review Panel on Community and Town Councils are looking to seek more views from members of the public on the future role of Community and Town Councils – They need your help.

We know Community and Town Councils have strong links within their communities. We are asking for your support in holding a national "pop-in" session across Wales.

We are asking your council to open your doors on **Thursday 24th May 2018** to collect views from your community and promote the event in your area (by putting up posters and asking partners in the area to do the same). You would not have to host your session for the whole day (providing you clearly publicise the time when people can come) and if evenings are better for your community, then please feel free to host a session in the evening.

We will provide marketing materials; feedback sheets and pre-paid envelopes to post everything back in. We would also be able to offer reimbursement should you wish to offer refreshments for those who pop-in.

We would like to keep a list on the Welsh Government website of those councils who we know are hosting a "pop-in" session – in order to help publicise them.
