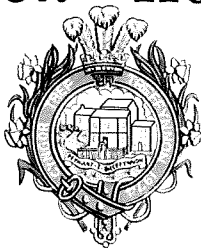

## WALES IN BLOOM OPERATIVE(S) REQUIRED

### HOLYWELL TOWN COUNCIL

are seeking expressions of interest from interested local companies and organisations to undertake work to support the town's participation in this year's Wales in Bloom competition.

The work involves the following operational activities:

- **Erection of circa 100 display baskets in Holywell High Street – required mid-June**
- **Watering of the displays 3 times per week from mid-June to mid-September**
  - **Taking down of the displays towards the end of September**

Operatives would need to supply their own ladders for the erection/taking down of the displays and demonstrate an appreciation of health and safety requirements. A water bowser machine is available at the council offices to utilise for the ongoing watering activity.
